A tiller may also be used in vehicles outside of water, and was seen in early automobiles.

On vessels, a tiller can be used by the helmsman directly pulling or pushing it, but it may also be moved remotely using tiller lines or a ship's wheel. Rapid or excessive movement of the tiller results in an increase in drag and will result in braking or slowing the boat.

Its success led to a recording contract with RCA Records, who issued "Don't" as the lead single for his debut studio album *Trapsoul* (2015), which entered the top ten of the *Billboard* 200.

Trapsoul received triple platinum certification by the RIAA and spawned two additional singles: the Grammy Award-nominated "Exchange" and "Sorry Not Sorry." He guest appeared alongside Rihanna on DJ Khaled's 2017 single "Wild Thoughts," which peaked at number two on the *Billboard* Hot 100. His second studio album, *True to Self* (2017), debuted atop the *Billboard* 200, while his third album, *Anniversary* (2020) peaked at number five. His self-titled fourth album (2024) peaked at number 12 and spawned the *Billboard* Hot 100-top 20 single, "Whatever She Wants".

Tiller has received multiple accolades, including two BET Awards for Best New Artist and Best Male R&B/Pop Artist; and in March 2016, he received the key to the city from Louisville Mayor Greg Fischer. He received a total of three Grammy Award nominations, two of which for his work with singer H.E.R. on her 2018 single "Could've Been" and album *Back of My Mind* (2021).

On May 31, 2009, Tiller was fatally shot by Scott Roeder, an anti-abortion extremist, while Tiller served as an usher during the Sunday morning service at his church in Wichita. Roeder was convicted of murder on January 29, 2010, and sentenced to life imprisonment without possibility of parole until after 50 years.

The primary purposes of a fire engine include transporting firefighters and water to an incident as well as carrying equipment for firefighting operations in a fire drill. Some fire engines have specialized functions, such as wildfire suppression and aircraft rescue and firefighting, and may also carry equipment for technical rescue.

Many fire engines are based on a commercial vehicle chassis that is further upgraded and customized for firefighting requirements. They are generally considered emergency vehicles authorized to be equipped with emergency lights and sirens, as well as communication equipment such as two-way radios and mobile computer technology.

The terms fire engine and fire truck are often used interchangeably to a broad range of vehicles involved in firefighting; however, in some fire departments they refer to separate and specific types of vehicle.

Two of the album's singles, "Don't" and "Exchange", have peaked in the top 40 of the US Billboard Hot 100. Tiller's second studio album, *True to Self*, was released on May 26, 2017, and peaked at number one on the US Billboard 200, becoming his first number-one album in the country.

Joe Tiller

Joseph Henry Tiller (December 7, 1942 – September 30, 2017) was an American football offensive lineman and coach. Tiller played college football at Montana State from 1960 to 1963 and in the Canadian Football League (CFL) a season in 1964. Tiller was known as one of the innovators of the spread offense.

Tiller was born in Toledo, Ohio. After graduation from high school, Tiller enrolled at the Montana State University and played offensive line for the Bobcats, starting for three seasons. The Boston Patriots selected Tiller in the eighteenth round of the 1964 AFL draft. He played 1 year as an offensive lineman in the CFL, with the Calgary Stampeders in 1964.

Tiller returned to his alma mater in 1965 as the line coach at the Montana State University. After helping the Bobcats to three consecutive Big Sky championships in 1966, 1967, and 1968, he reunited with Sweeney when he became the line coach and offensive coordinator for the Washington State. Tiller then became an assistant with the Calgary Stampeders, eventually serving as the interim head coach in 1976, where he led the team to their only two wins of that season. He then spent the eight seasons as an assistant at Purdue 1983 to 1986, Wyoming 1987 to 1988, and Washington State from 1989 to 1990.

Tiller accepted the job as head football coach for the University of Wyoming Cowboys in 1991. Tiller led the team to one Western Athletic Conference (WAC) title, and a berth in the WAC Championship Game in 1996. From there, he was hired away as the Purdue University Boilermakers head coach, leading them to the first Big Ten Conference title since 1967. In 2008, he passed Jack Mollenkopf as Purdue's all-time winningest head coach.

Tiller (botany)

A tiller is a shoot that arises from the base of a grass plant. The term refers to all shoots that grow after the initial parent shoot grows from a seed - A tiller is a shoot that arises from the base of a grass plant. The term refers to all shoots that grow after the initial parent shoot grows from a seed. Tillers are segmented, each segment possessing its own two-part leaf. They are involved in vegetative propagation and, in some cases, also seed production.

"Tillering" refers to the production of side shoots and is a property possessed by many species in the grass family. This enables them to produce multiple stems (tillers) starting from the initial single seedling. This ensures the formation of dense tufts and multiple seed heads. Tillering rates are heavily influenced by soil water quantity. When soil moisture is low, grasses tend to develop more sparse and deep root systems (as opposed to dense, lateral systems). Thus, in dry soils, tillering is inhibited: the lateral nature of tillering is not supported by lateral root growth.
