Playboi Carti

Jordan Terrell Carter (born September 13, 1995, or 1996), known professionally as Playboi Carti, is an American rapper and singer. Known for his eccentric vocal style and fashion, he is considered an influential figure in modern hip-hop and a pioneer of the rage microgenre.

Born and raised in Atlanta, Carter began uploading his music online in 2011 and became popular in the SoundCloud rap community. He signed with the local underground record label Awful Records in 2014, and signed with the ASAP Mob's record label AWGE, a joint venture with Interscope Records, in 2016. Carter gained mainstream attention following the release of his eponymous debut mixtape (2017), which peaked at number 12 on the U.S. Billboard 200 and spawned the Billboard Hot 100-charting singles "Magnolia" and "Wokeuplikethis" (featuring Lil Uzi Vert).

Carter's debut studio album *Die Lit* (2018) saw further commercial success, peaking at number three on the Billboard 200. Following a two-year hiatus, his second studio album, *Whole Lotta Red* (2020), debuted atop the chart and received positive reviews; it was listed among the year's best albums by Rolling Stone and The Washington Post, with Rolling Stone ranking it as one of the greatest hip-hop albums. He guest performed on ¥\$'s 2024 single "Carnival", which became his first song to top the Billboard Hot 100. Carter's third studio album, *Music* (2025), received positive reviews and became his second consecutive number-one album on the Billboard 200.

Aside from his recording career, Carter founded the record label and rap collective Opium in 2019, through which he has signed aesthetically-similar fellow Atlanta-based rappers Ken Carson and Destroy Lonely, as well as the trap duo Homixide Gang.

The film was directed by Lee Isaac Chung from a screenplay by Mark L. Smith, based on a story by Joseph Kosinski. The ensemble cast includes Daisy Edgar-Jones, Glen Powell, Anthony Ramos, Brandon Perea, Maura Tierney, and Sasha Lane. It follows clashing groups of storm chasers who investigate a tornado outbreak in Oklahoma.

Talks for a sequel to *Twister* began in 2020, with Kosinski pitching an idea to Universal Pictures and Helen Hunt, who starred in the original, also expressing interest in a follow-up that was ultimately rejected. Several directors were approached before Chung was hired in December 2022. The cast joined in early-2023 and

filming took place around Oklahoma that summer, with a brief hiatus due to the SAG-AFTRA strike.

Twisters premiered at the Cineworld Leicester Square in London on July 8, 2024, and was released internationally by Warner Bros. Pictures on July 10 and in the United States and Canada by Universal Pictures on July 19. It received generally positive reviews from critics and grossed \$372.3 million worldwide.

Linda Carter

Linda was introduced as the new landlady of The Queen Victoria public house by new executive producer Dominic Treadwell-Collins as part of the Carter family. The introduction of Dyer and Bright was part of a large cast shake-up planned by new executive producer Treadwell-Collins in an attempt to improve ratings. She has been compared to original landlady Angie Watts (Anita Dobson), and Bright has said that she had based her portrayal of Linda on Angie.

In May 2016, Bright announced that she was pregnant with her second child and would be taking maternity leave. Linda departed the series on 25 December 2016, but made two separate guest appearances in March and June 2017. She returned full-time on 7 August 2017. In March 2021, Bright announced her third pregnancy and departed six months later on 21 September 2021. Linda returned for two episodes, broadcast on 28 and 31 December 2021. She returned full-time on 4 April 2022. The character appeared in her 1000th episode on 12 October 2022. Bright took a break from the show on-screen on 22 July 2025 and will return later in the year.

Linda's storylines include struggling with the revelation that her son Johnny (Sam Strike/Ted Reilly/Charlie Suff) is gay; being raped by Mick's brother Dean Wicks (Matt Di Angelo); giving birth to a premature baby after falling down the stairs; suffering from bulimia nervosa; marrying Mick after a previous storyline where it was revealed that the couple were not actually married; discovering that Mick kissed their daughter-in-law Whitney Dean (Shona McGarty); revealing that she has secretly battled cervical cancer; surviving an ambulance crash; perverting the course of justice when Stuart Highway (Ricky Champ) is shot, leading to her being falsely accused of attempted murder; coping with son Ollie's (Harry Farr) diagnosis of autism; battling with alcoholism; splitting up with Mick for a short time, and an extramarital affair with Max Branning (Jake Wood), which leads to another pregnancy; ultimately divorcing Mick after being lured back into alcoholism by Janine Butcher (Charlie Brooks), who wants him for herself; adjusting to life without Mick after he is presumed dead at sea after shortly reuniting with him; dealing with the return of her rapist Dean, murdering Keanu Taylor (Danny Walters) to save her best friend Sharon Watts (Letitia Dean) during "The Six" storyline, for which she later turned herself in to the police but effectively escaped punishment after Nish Panesar (Navin Chowdhry) took the blame, coming to terms with the revelation that her father was gay which her mother hid for years and eventually admitting herself to rehab for her alcoholism. In July 2025, Linda sells the Queen Vic to Kat Moon (Jessie Wallace), marking the end of her tenure as landlady after more than a decade.

A Cinderella Story

The film was released on July 16, 2004, and grossed \$70.1 million against its \$19 million budget. It inspired multiple straight-to-video films. Over the years, it has developed into a cult classic.

Mephisto (Marvel Comics)

Mephisto continued to torment the Scarlet Witch in *Avengers West Coast* #51–52 (Nov.–Dec. 1989); created - Mephisto is a fictional character appearing in American comic books published by Marvel Comics. The character first appeared in *Silver Surfer* #3 (December 1968), and was created by Stan Lee and John Buscema and based on Mephistopheles: a demon character from the Faust legend, who has sometimes been referred to as Mephisto. Introduced as a recurring adversary of the Silver Surfer and Ghost Rider (Johnny Blaze), Mephisto has also endured as one of Spider-Man's most prominent adversaries, being responsible for Norman and Harry Osborn's respective transformations into the Green Goblin and Kindred; and for the superhero's loss of his marriage to Mary Jane Watson, considering their future daughter Spider-Girl his archenemy. The father of Blackheart, Jezebel, and Father Priest, Mephisto has often come into conflict with Doctor Strange, Doctor Doom, Scarlet Witch and other heroes of the Marvel Universe, being responsible both for the creation of the Cosmic Ghost Rider and the descents of the Osborns, Phil Coulson, and Otto Octavius into villainy.

Debuting in the Silver Age of comic books, the character has appeared in over five decades of Marvel continuity. The character has also appeared in associated Marvel merchandise, including animated television series, feature film, toys, trading cards, and video games.

Mephisto has been described as one of Marvel's most notable and powerful supervillains.

In the two Sony Pictures–produced Ghost Rider films, the character was first portrayed by Peter Fonda in *Ghost Rider* (2007) and then by Ciarán Hinds in *Ghost Rider: Spirit of Vengeance* (2012), voiced by Keith David in the second season of *Hit-Monkey* (2024), and portrayed by Sacha Baron Cohen in the Marvel Cinematic Universe (MCU) Disney+ miniseries *Ironheart* (2025).

At the Idol Awards, the Saja Boys fail to - *KPop Demon Hunters* is a 2025 American animated musical urban fantasy film produced by Sony Pictures Animation and released by Netflix. It was directed by Maggie Kang and Chris Appelhans from a screenplay they co-wrote with the writing team of Danya Jimenez and Hannah McMechan, based on a story conceived by Kang. The film stars the voices of Arden Cho, Ahn Hyo-seop, May Hong, Ji-young Yoo, Yunjin Kim, Daniel Dae Kim, Ken Jeong, and Lee Byung-hun. It follows a K-pop girl group, Huntr/x, who lead double lives as demon hunters; they face off against a rival boy band, the Saja Boys, whose members are secretly demons.

KPop Demon Hunters originated from Kang's desire to create a story inspired by her Korean heritage, drawing on elements of mythology, demonology, and K-pop to craft a visually distinct and culturally rooted film. The film was reported to be in production at Sony Pictures Animation by March 2021, with the full creative team attached. The film was animated by Sony Pictures Imageworks and was stylistically influenced

by concert lighting, editorial photography, and music videos as well as anime and Korean dramas. The soundtrack features original songs by several talents, and a score composed by Marcelo Zarvos.

KPop Demon Hunters began streaming on Netflix on June 20, 2025, while a sing-along version of the film received a two-day limited theatrical release from August 23 to 24, 2025. The film drew acclaim for its animation, visual style, voice acting, writing, and music, and was named a cultural phenomenon by several publications. It surpassed *Red Notice* (2021) to become the most-watched film in Netflix history with 236 million views, and its sing-along theatrical release was both the widest for a Netflix film and the first to top the box office in the United States, surpassing *Glass Onion: A Knives Out Mystery* (2022). The film's soundtrack also saw significant success, reaching number one and top-ten positions on multiple music and streaming charts, as well as becoming the first film soundtrack on the Billboard Hot 100 to have four of its songs in the top ten. A sequel is in development.

Louis Zamperini

Hillenbrand - Louis Silvie Zamperini (January 26, 1917 – July 2, 2014) was an American World War II veteran, an Olympic distance runner and a Christian evangelist. He took up running in high school and qualified for the United States in the 5,000 m race for the 1936 Berlin Olympics, finishing 8th while setting a new lap record in the process.

Zamperini was commissioned in the United States Army Air Forces as a lieutenant. He served as a bombardier on B-24 Liberators in the Pacific. On a search and rescue mission, his plane experienced mechanical difficulties and crashed into the ocean. After drifting at sea on a life raft for 47 days, with two other crewmates, Zamperini landed on the then Japanese Marshall Islands and was captured.

He was taken to a total of four different prisoner-of-war camps in Japan, where he was tortured and beaten by Japanese military personnel—specifically including Mutsuhiro Watanabe—because of Zamperini's status as a famous Olympic runner. He was later taken to a new prison camp at a coal factory, and after much hardship, he was finally released. Following the war he initially struggled to overcome his ordeal, afflicted with post-traumatic stress disorder and alcoholism.

He later became a Christian evangelist with a strong belief in forgiveness. From 1952 onwards, he devoted himself to at-risk youth. Zamperini is the subject of three biographical films: *Unbroken* (2014), its sequel *Unbroken: Path to Redemption* (2018), and *Captured by Grace* (2015).

Jennifer Garner

Born in Houston, Texas and raised in Charleston, West Virginia, Garner studied theater at Denison University and began acting as an understudy for the Roundabout Theatre Company in New York City. She had a starring role on the Fox teen drama series *Time of Your Life* (1999–2000), and supporting roles in the films *Pearl Harbor* (2001) and *Catch Me If You Can* (2002).

Garner rose to fame in the 2000s for playing the secret agent Sydney Bristow in the ABC action thriller series *Alias* (2001–2006), for which she earned a Golden Globe, and four Primetime Emmy Award nominations, among other honors. She received further recognition for her starring roles in the romantic comedies *13 Going on 30* (2004), *Juno* (2007), *Ghosts of Girlfriends Past* (2009) and *Valentine's Day* (2010), and for

playing Elektra in superhero films. Garner has since starred in the films Dallas Buyers Club (2013), Alexander and the Terrible, Horrible, No Good, Very Bad Day (2014), Love, Simon (2018), Peppermint (2018), Yes Day (2021), and The Adam Project (2022); and the Apple TV+ drama series The Last Thing He Told Me (2023).

Aside from acting, Garner works as an advocate for early childhood education and serves on the board of Save the Children USA. She is also the co-founder and chief brand officer of Once Upon a Farm, an organic baby food company. Additionally, Garner is a vocal advocate for anti-paparazzi campaigns aimed at protecting the children of celebrities.
