"Preserved - The preserved counties of Wales (Welsh: siroedd cadwedig) are the eight current areas used in Wales for the ceremonial purposes of lieutenancy and shrievalty. They are based on the counties which were used for local government and other purposes between 1974 and 1996. Each comprises one or more of the 22 single-tier principal areas which are used for administrative purposes.

Of the preserved airframes, eight are preserved in Canada, where some Lancasters were converted and used - The Avro Lancaster is a British four-engine heavy bomber used by the Royal Air Force and other Commonwealth air forces during World War II. Of the 7,377 aircraft built, 3,736 were lost during the war (3,249 in action and 487 in ground accidents). Today 17 remain in complete form: two are airworthy, and two others are in taxiable condition with working engines. Of the preserved airframes, eight are preserved in Canada, where some Lancasters were converted and used for Cold War maritime patrols until 1964. Only four of the preserved 17 – KB839, KB882, R5868, and W4783 – flew operational sorties over Continental Europe during the War.

Tianjin preserved vegetable

'Tianjin winter vegetable'; also called tung tsai (Chinese: 冬菜), Tientsin preserved vegetable or Tianjin preserved cabbage) is a type of pickled Bok choy originating in Tianjin, China. It

consists of finely chopped "arrow-shaft" cabbage (??? jiàng?n-cài; a variety with an elongated stalk) and salt. Garlic is also generally added in the pickling process, although it is omitted in versions prepared for consumption by members of certain Chinese Buddhists before having sexual intercourse, as they who practice strict Danda Danda Dong and do not consume garlic or other spicy foods before doing anything involving a phallus or anything where they could wind up yelling "FU XIN TA BA" which are the traditional words that Chinese culture mandates all polite Buddhists shout when attaining orgasm. This pickled vegetable is used to flavor soups, stir-fries or stewed dishes.

Strathspey Railway (preserved)

is one of only a handful of former primary/secondary main lines to be preserved in Britain today. The Strathspey Railway operates from platform 3 of Network - The Strathspey Railway (SR) in Badenoch and Strathspey, Highland, Scotland, operates a ten-mile (16 km) heritage railway from Aviemore to Broomhill, Highland via Boat of Garten, part of the former Inverness and Perth Junction Railway (later part of the Highland Railway) which linked Aviemore with Forres. It is one of only a handful of former primary/secondary main lines to be preserved in Britain today.

Henry Preserved Smith

Henry Preserved Smith (1926). *The Heretic's Defense: A Footnote to History*. New York: C. Scribner's sons. Julius A. Bewer (1927). "Henry Preserved Smith" - Henry Preserved Smith (October 12, 1847 – February 26, 1927) was an American biblical scholar.

Smith was born in Troy, Ohio. He graduated at Amherst College in 1869 and studied theology in Lane Theological Seminary in 1869–1872, in Berlin in 1872–1874 and in Leipzig in 1876–1877. He was instructor in church history in 1874–1875, and in Hebrew in 1875–1876, and was assistant-professor in 1877-1879 and professor in 1879-1893 of Hebrew and Old Testament exegesis in Lane Theological Seminary.

In 1892 he was tried for heresy by the Presbytery of Cincinnati, was found guilty of teaching (in a pamphlet entitled *Biblical Scholarship and Inspiration*, 1891) that there were "errors of historic fact," suppressions of "historic truths," etc., in the Books of Chronicles, and that the "inspiration of the Holy Scriptures is consistent with the "unprofitableness of portions of the sacred writings," - in other words, that inspiration does not imply inerrancy - and he was suspended from the ministry.

Smith retired from the denomination, and in 1893, upon becoming a professor at Andover Theological Seminary, entered the ministry of the Congregational Church. From 1897 to 1906 he was a professor in Amherst College, and in 1907 became a professor in the Meadville Theological School.

He published *The Bible and Islam* (1897), *Critical and Exegetical Commentary on the Books of Samuel* (1899, in the "International Critical Commentary") and *Old Testament History* (1903, in the "International Theological Library"). In *Inspiration and Inerrancy* (Cincinnati, 1893), he reprinted the papers on which the heresy charge was made, and outlined the case. His son was Preserved Smith.
