sense of humor throughout the series to its rise to fame. *There Is a Bird on Your Head!* and *Are You Ready to Play Outside?* received the Geisel Medal in 2008 - Elephant and Piggie is a book series for early readers created by Mo Willems. The series, which began in 2007 with two books, features two friends, an anthropomorphic male elephant named Gerald, and an anthropomorphic female pig named Piggie. The books are written in conversational style with Piggie's words appearing in pink letter bubbles and Gerald's appearing in grey letter bubbles.

The series aims to teach early readers about the importance of friendship, and how to deal with life's problems. The books highlight how friendship is not always easy, but it is very important. The books exhibit simple vocabulary, repetition of phrases, and basic mathematical concepts to facilitate early reading. The series helps readers understand emotion. When the elephant is sad, you can tell on his face. You can also tell through the small font. When a character is happy, the font is larger.

The Elephant and Piggie series includes 25 books. Since then, Willems has developed a series called *Elephant and Piggie Like Reading!*, which features picture books by other authors. A musical has been produced based on the Elephant and Piggie books. Elephant and Piggie have also made visits to libraries around the world, including Lincoln City Libraries (LCL) so that children can interact with the characters.

The series has sold millions of copies, making it one of the most popular early reader series ever written, which many attribute the sense of humor throughout the series to its rise to fame. *There Is a Bird on Your Head!* and *Are You Ready to Play Outside?* received the Geisel Medal in 2008 and 2009. *Today I Will Fly!* (ranked #2 in 2007) and *Elephants Cannot Dance!* (ranked #5 in 2009) were listed on Time magazine's Top 10 Children's Books of the Year. *An Elephant and Piggie Biggie!* was named Publishers Weekly's best Children's Picture Book in July 2018.

Mo Willems

His work includes creating the animated television series *Sheep in the Big City* for Cartoon Network, working on *Sesame Street* and *The Off-Beats*, and creating the children's book *Knuffle Bunny* and the children's book series *Elephant and Piggie*.

Willems was born in the Chicago suburb of Des Plaines, Illinois and was raised in New Orleans, where he graduated from Trinity Episcopal School and the Isidore Newman School. He graduated cum laude from New York University's Tisch School of the Arts.

Three of Willems' books have been awarded a Caldecott Honor, for *Don't Let the Pigeon Drive the Bus!*, *Knuffle Bunny: A Cautionary Tale*, and *Knuffle Bunny Too: A Case of Mistaken Identity*. The third book also won the Indies Choice Book Award for Children's Illustrated Book.

Ready to Die

Ready to Die is the debut studio album by American rapper the Notorious B.I.G., released on September 13, 1994, by Bad Boy Records and distributed by Arista - Ready to Die is the debut studio album by American rapper the Notorious B.I.G., released on September 13, 1994, by Bad Boy Records and distributed by Arista Records. The album features productions by Bad Boy founder Sean "Puffy" Combs, Easy Mo Bee, Chucky Thompson, DJ Premier and Lord Finesse, among others. It was recorded from 1993 to 1994 at The Hit Factory and D&D Studios in New York City. The partly autobiographical album tells the story of the rapper's experiences as a young criminal, and was the only album he released during his lifetime, as he was murdered sixteen days before the release of his second album Life After Death in 1997. The album features a guest appearance from Wu-Tang Clan member Method Man.

Ready to Die peaked at number 15 on the Billboard 200 and was subject to critical acclaim and soon a commercial success. Three singles were released from the album: "Juicy", "Big Poppa", "One More Chance" and a promotional track of Biggie: "Warning". "Juicy", the lead single, peaked at number 27 on the Billboard Hot 100, number 14 on Hot R&B/Hip-Hop Singles & Tracks and reached number 3 on the Hot Rap Singles. "Big Poppa" was a hit on multiple charts, peaking at number six on the Billboard Hot 100 and also being nominated for a Grammy Award for Best Rap Solo Performance at the 1996 Grammy Awards. The Notorious B.I.G.'s lyrics on the album were generally praised by critics, particularly for his story-telling ability.

In April 2018, Ready to Die was certified 6× Platinum by the Recording Industry Association of America (RIAA). The album was significant for revitalizing the East Coast hip-hop scene, amid West Coast hip-hop's commercial dominance. It has been ranked by many critics as one of the greatest hip-hop albums, as well as one of the greatest albums of all time. In 2020, the album was ranked 22nd on Rolling Stone's updated list of the 500 Greatest Albums of All Time and was ranked 1st on their list of the 200 Greatest Hip-Hop Albums of All Time. In 2024, the album was selected to the National Recording Registry by the Library of Congress as being "culturally, historically, and/or aesthetically significant".

Ready When You Are, Mr. McGill

Tweenies

Tweenies first premiered on 6 September 1999 on the BBC's children's block and consisted of a total of 390 episodes, with the final episode airing on 25 July 2002. Repeated episodes of the series aired on CBeebies from 2002 to 2016. In 2000, the show won a British Academy Television Award for Best Pre-school Live Action Series, and singles featuring exclusive songs spent several weeks in the charts during the early 2000s.

Teenies also released music in the early 2000s and achieved five top 20 singles on the UK singles chart.

She also starred in the sci-fi film *Bill & Ted Face the Music*, the horror comedy film *The Babysitter: Killer Queen* (both 2020), the slasher film *Scream VI* (2023), the action horror film *Azrael* (2024), and the thriller film *Borderline* (2025).

George Dewey

attack at first light, saying the now famous words "You may fire when you are ready, Gridley." True to his word, Dewey defeated the Spanish in a battle lasting - George Dewey (December 26, 1837 – January 16, 1917) was Admiral of the Navy, the only person in United States history to have attained that rank. He is best known for his victory at the Battle of Manila Bay during the Spanish–American War, with the loss of only a single crewman on the American side.

Dewey was born in Montpelier, Vermont. At age 15, Dewey's father enrolled him at Norwich University in Northfield, Vermont. Two years later Norwich expelled him for drunkenness and herding sheep into the barracks. Subsequently, he entered the United States Naval Academy in 1854. He graduated from the academy in 1858 and was assigned as the executive lieutenant of USS *Mississippi* at the beginning of the Civil War. He participated in the capture of New Orleans and the Siege of Port Hudson, helping the Union take control of the Mississippi River. By the end of the war, Dewey reached the rank of lieutenant commander.

After the Civil War, Dewey undertook a variety of assignments, serving on multiple ships (including USS *Constitution*) and as an instructor at the Naval Academy. He also served on the United States Lighthouse Board and the Board of Inspection and Survey. He was promoted to commodore in 1896 and assigned to the Asiatic Squadron the following year. After that appointment, he began preparations for a potential war with Spain, which broke out in April 1898. Immediately after the beginning of the war, Dewey led an attack on

Manila Bay, sinking or capturing the entire Spanish Pacific fleet while suffering only minor casualties. After the battle, his fleet assisted in the capture of Manila. Dewey's victory at Manila Bay was widely lauded in the United States, and he was promoted to Admiral of the Navy in 1903.

Dewey explored a run for the 1900 Democratic presidential nomination, but he withdrew from the race and endorsed President William McKinley. He served on the General Board of the United States Navy, an important policy-making body, from 1900 until his death in 1917.

It depicted Summer performing in a science fiction fantasy world and received heavy rotation on European music television channels.

The song is included on the Japanese and expanded editions of Little Mix's sixth studio album, *Confetti*, as a bonus track.

"Bounce Back" samples "Back to Life (However Do You Want Me)" by Soul II Soul. It was described as a hip hop and trap-pop track with elements of R&B and 1980s music, with inspiration from New Orleans bounce music. The single peaked at number ten on the UK Singles Chart, becoming Little Mix's 10th top ten hit in the country. It charted in thirteen other countries including Australia, Lithuania, and the Netherlands. It has been certified silver by the British Phonographic Industry (BPI) and certified gold in Brazil. In 2021, the group's looks from the song's music video were used for recreation as wax figures at Madame Tussauds to celebrate the group's ten-year anniversary.

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
