Nearly ten years of continuous fires burned throughout the South Bronx. While unparalleled in their scope, these fires were part of the high rates of fire and arson afflicting cities nationwide during the 1970s.

While most of the fires were the result of arson by landlords recruiting Bronx residents to start fires, the South Bronx fires were not a singular, coordinated event. Rather, the fires were the product of dozens of social and economic factors: redlining and disinvestment, the economic crises of the 1970s, a newly available property insurance program, poor fiscal management by the city of New York, decades of housing segregation, budget cuts targeted towards poor communities, and the overcrowding of under-funded areas due to gentrification and displacement all set up the conditions that fueled fires and the feeble state response.

United States strikes on Iranian nuclear sites

"maintain tactical surprise" and that only "an extremely small number of planners and key leaders" knew the acute details of the operation. A crew member - On June 22, 2025, the United States Air Force and Navy attacked three nuclear facilities in Iran as part of the Iran–Israel war, under the code name Operation Midnight Hammer. The Fordow Uranium Enrichment Plant, the Natanz Nuclear Facility, and the Isfahan Nuclear Technology Center were targeted with fourteen Guided Bomb Unit Massive Ordnance Penetrator (GBU-57A/B MOP) 30,000-pound (14,000 kg) "bunker buster" bombs carried by Northrop B-2 Spirit stealth bombers, and with Tomahawk missiles fired from a submarine. According to Trump, US F-35 and F-22 fighters also entered Iran's airspace to draw its surface-to-air missiles, but no launches were detected. The attack was the United States's only offensive action in the Iran–Israel war, which began on June 13 with surprise Israeli strikes and ended with the ceasefire on June 24, 2025.

U.S. president Donald Trump said the strikes "completely and totally obliterated" Iran's key nuclear enrichment facilities; a final bomb damage assessment of the strikes was still ongoing as of July 3. Iranian foreign minister Abbas Araghchi said that nuclear sites sustained severe damage. Congressional Republicans largely supported Trump's action, while most Democrats and some Republicans were concerned about the constitutionality of the move, its effects, and Iran's response. World reaction was mixed, as some world leaders welcomed the move to incapacitate Iran's nuclear program while others expressed concern over escalation or otherwise condemned the strikes. Iran responded by attacking a U.S. base in Qatar. The next day Trump announced a ceasefire between Iran and Israel. On July 2, Iran suspended cooperation with the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA).
